We are a forward-looking company, adopting a "learning without limits" philosophy. This means that everyone working in our establishments has a passionate conviction that all our young people are able to achieve; we are optimistic about success and accept no restriction on what is possible with the young people in our care, and whose development and learning is in our hands.

We believe in a 'no limits' approach to helping children and young adults.

Tower Hill (Supported) is a provision providing supported accommodation for young people aged 16 and above, giving them access to vital support to develop their life skills further and lead to independent living as they move into adulthood. It is situated near our existing provision for young adults over 18. The supportive environment offers nurture, guidance and time to allow the young people flourish, giving opportunities to access further education, employment and continue development of life skills. The aim of the provision is to deliver high-quality support, making young people feel safe and secure within their surroundings with other young people, all working towards independent living.

- Accommodation which is decorated, maintained and furnished to a high standard and overseen by the Support Manager.
- Personalised decoration of bedrooms.
- Maintenance of the property by our team.
- A tailored package to suit the needs of each individual; we run on a baseline of 10 hours support for each young person but can increase this if necessary.
- Each individual will have a key worker along with access to the wider team.
- Accommodation is available 365 days a year with 24-hour telephone support.
- Support to register with local health providers.


- Support accessing education, employment and training.
- Assistance with financial matters and help in establishing the financial support available to them.
- Support in gaining advocacy services.
- Working through our bespoke life skills programme to support each individual towards independent living.
- Participation through activities to bring the community together; movie and games nights, cultural events, activities away from the home.
- We have access to professionals such as a Child and Adolescent
 Psychiatrist and therapeutic support if required.



We believe in children's and young adults' abilities and potential.

- 4-bedroomed, end terrace property with garden.
- Accommodation for up to 3 young people.
- All bedrooms are fully furnished with a bed, wardrobe, bedside table and chest of drawers. All rooms have aerial points for a television if required.
- 24/7 access to staff support via a key contact number.
- Close proximately to our residential provision for post 18s, which is staffed 24/7
- Large kitchen area providing space for all young people, including;
 - Dining area.
 - Fridge freezer to share and additional fridge to ensure all young people have the space required.
 - Washing machine and tumble dryer.
- Large lounge area providing the opportunity to relax and watch television, or to complete any required study work.
- One bathroom (with shower over bath).
- Downstairs toilet.
- WiFi access throughout the property.





Location:

Tower Hill is situated on the outskirts of Beccles, a small market town on the River Waveney, giving the opportunity to live in quiet surroundings but within walking distance of local amenities, such as;

- Various options for public transport, whether this be bus or train.
- Selection of supermarkets and smaller independent shops.
- Doctors, dentist, opticians and pharmacy all within a 15-minute walk.
